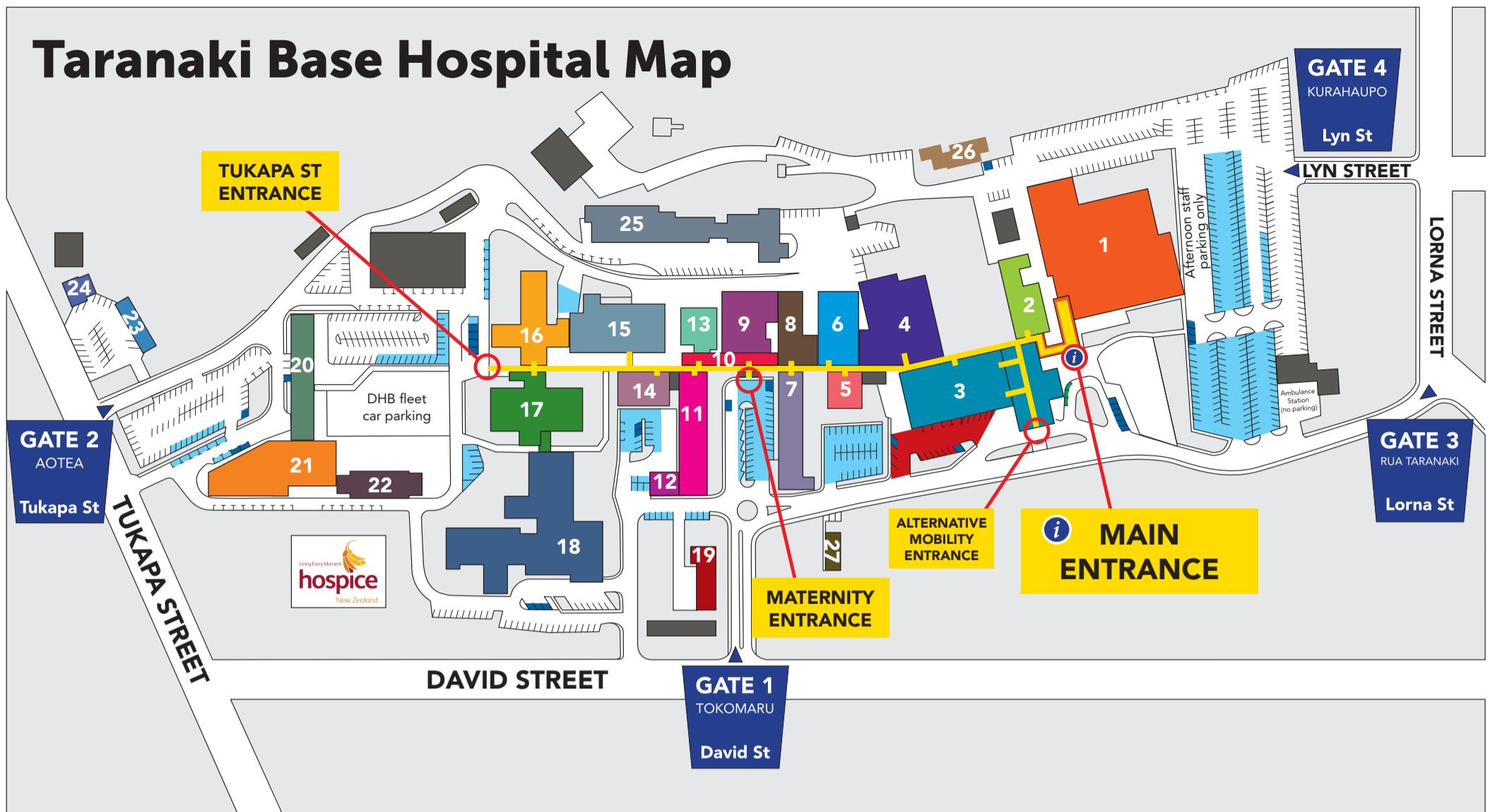








# Taranaki Base Hospital Map
